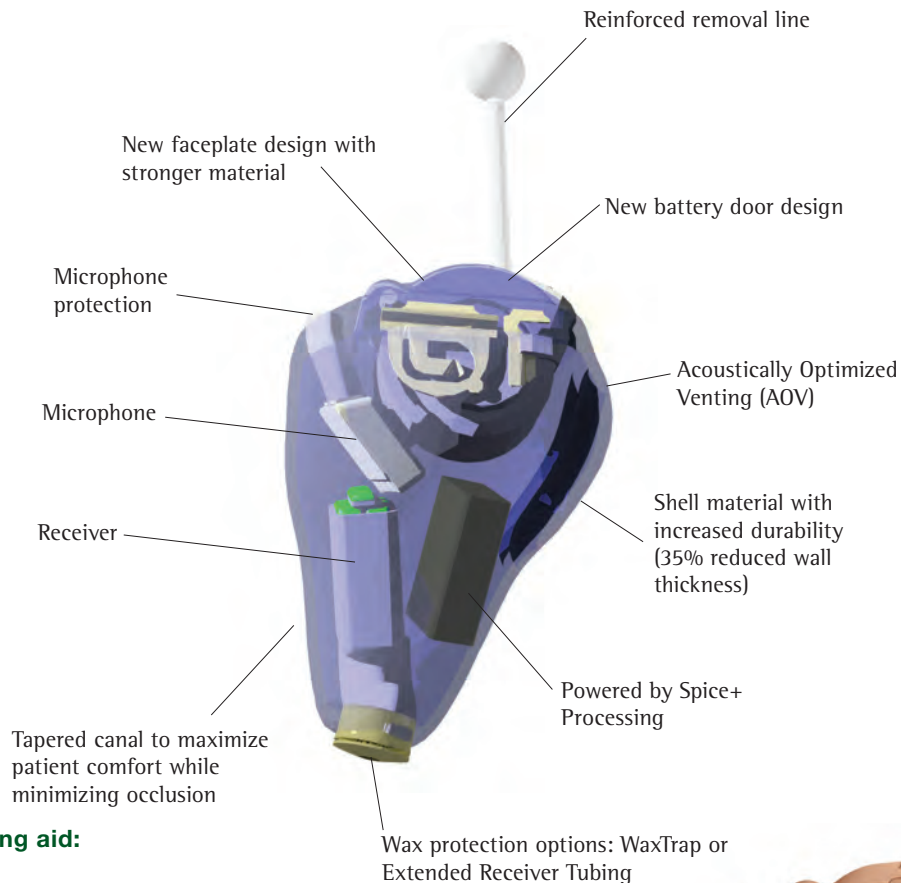


HRP's Just the Specs
